RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Council Award is called the "ISH SODI" Award – As Cryptic Masons we are taught "ISH SODI" means "Select Man, or Man of My Choice." The Council Award should represent Select Men.

RULES:

- 1. Committees should be appointed for award recipients by the High Priest, Illustrious Master and Commander, of each York Rite Body no later than December 31st of each year. These Committees will serve from January 1st until a successor is appointed. It is suggested that Past Elected Officers serve on these committees and could be past award recipients as well.
- 2. Awards should be made as the committee recommends, and as approved by the Grand High Priest, Illustrious Grand Master, and Grand Commander, but each award is limited to no more than one annually. Awards are to be made only when the committee makes a recommendation and do not have to be given at specified intervals. It is not necessary to make an award each year.
- 3. The committee should review the membership each year and ascertain if the Chapter, Council, and/or Commandery has a worthy Companion or Sir Knight who should be considered for each award. The report should be made to the respective head of each body. The High Priest, Illustrious Master and Commander reports the recommendation to the Grand High Priest, Illustrious Grand Master, and Grand Commander, respectively.
- 4. All recommendations for these awards are to be reviewed by the Grand High Priest, Illustrious Grand Master, and Grand Commander, or their designees and all such recommendations shall have the final approval of the Grand High Priest, Illustrious Grand Master, and Grand Commander, respectively.
- 5. Preparations for the presentations of these awards should be made by the current head of each body and under guidelines of each of the committees.
- 6. The Grand High Priest, Illustrious Grand Master and Grand Commander, or their representatives should be invited to be present and assist in the presentation of each of the awards.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. For a member to be eligible for either of these awards, He must have at least **5**years of continuous service as a Royal Arch Mason, Cryptic Mason, or Knight Templar, respectively.
- 2. Regular attendance and support of the York Rite Bodies should be considered.
- 3. Ritual performance should be considered but is not required or mandatory for consideration of the awards.
- 4. Service as an Officer is not required but should be considered by the committee.
- 5. Members who have been suspended and then reinstated should be strictly reviewed as to the circumstances of the suspension and all factors taken into consideration.
- 6. Members for consideration of these awards should be distinguished by exceptional character, and humility, regarding service to The York Rite Bodies.
- 7. Membership in Honorary or Invitational Bodies is not required, but such membership and activity could be considered as secondary factors.

AWARD PLANNING, REQUESTS AND FEES:

- The High Priest, Illustrious Master, and Commander of each Constituent York Rite Body shall appoint a committee of 3 members to select the recipients of the awards.
- The committee will review the membership and select a worthy Companion to be considered to receive The Keystone Award, The ISH SODI Award, and a Worthy Sir Knight for the Meritorious Service Award.
- These recommendations will be forwarded to The Grand High Priest, Illustrious Grand Master, and Grand Commander respectively through the Office of The Grand Secretary/Recorder, at least 3 weeks prior the anticipated presentation date.
- A FEE OF <u>\$25.00</u> SHALL ACCOMPANY the recommendation for each of the 3 awards. This fee covers the cost of the awards, as well as a certificate suitable for framing.
- The recommendations will be considered by the Grand High Priest, Illustrious Grand Master, and Grand Commander respectively, and notifications will be made through the Office of The Grand Secretary/Recorder, the award recipients are approved or denied.
- The Grand York Rite is 100 percent behind recognition of your nominee. Everything will be done to accommodate your request. Denials will only be made for just cause by the Grand Head of the body.

The ability to honor Veterans and their service on behalf of their country was implemented in September of 2018. Service above self is one of the most laudable characteristics a Companion can embody, and Cryptic Masons International has developed the Cryptic Mason Veterans Medal to distinguish those among us who have answered that call.

The Cryptic Mason Veterans Award is rich in symbolism and honors a Veteran's Service while simultaneously displaying the character of Cryptic Masonry.

- In its center, it has the title "Veteran", along with the Broken Triangle emblem from the Seal. This not only refers to the Cryptic Degrees, but also alludes to the concept that "All gave some, but some gave all."
- Surrounding this is a Golden ring with 27 stars, representing the 27 who were chosen to work in the Secret Vault, and selfless service to benefit mankind.
- Enclosing this ring is a 9-pointed star, composed of 9 silver trowels. This references the 9 arches of Cryptic Masonry, as well as the spreading of that mystic cement which unites us as a band of Brothers.
- Behind these are the laurel leaves, which signify this award comes from the General Grand Council and represents the laurel leaves of victory.

It is our honor to make this award available to all Cryptic Masons who have served, and we hope that all Veterans who are Cryptic Masons will wear it with such pride and honor that it may distinguish you as a Select Master whose dedication to service has been tried, tested and proven.

Many people ensure the future of our society by supporting the Masonic Family Youth Organizations. Advisors, Dads and Moms are an integral part of keeping these organizations operating and offering the opportunity and knowledge of how to lead a moral and well-balanced life to our maturing generations and offer opportunities for their members to be exposed to the adult organizations.

As of the 33rd Triennial, the General Grand Council makes available one Adult Youth Leadership Award to each Grand Council to recognize a volunteer from the International Order of Rainbow for Girls, Jobs Daughters International or DeMolay International within their jurisdiction. We currently also support the Organization of Triangles, Inc., a youth organization for young ladies between the ages of 10 and 21 years old, in New York State. In 1996, this award became available to recognize non-Masons, including ladies. Since 1978, some hundreds have been awarded, but this award is currently under-utilized as a method of encouraging the support of youth groups and the awareness of the Council. The following rules apply to the dissemination of the award:

- A. One medal may be awarded annually in each Grand Council.
- B. Only one medal may be awarded triennially in each Constituent Council of the General Grand Council.
- C. Each Grand Council and each Constituent Council shall determine its own method of selecting their nominee.
- D. No posthumous awards shall be made.
- E. The award shall be made for exceptional and meritorious service above and beyond the call of duty.
- F. The General Grand Recorder shall be given the Annual Awards Form for a Grand Council filled out in full by the Grand Recorder at least thirty (30) days in advance of the Grand Assembly (or date of presentation if different), forty-five (45) days if outside the continental United States. Constituent Councils shall give the form with the information of the selected Cryptic Mason at least six months prior to the next Triennial Assembly. These timelines allow for engraving, packaging, and shipping, as well as some time for ensuring that all arrives as it should.
- G. The General Grand Recorder shall cause the name of the honoree to be engraved upon the medal and forwarded to the Grand Recorder or Recorder, if to a Constituent Council, at the earliest time following receipt of the completed form.

The 32nd Triennium of the General Grand Council saw the establishment of this award for each Grand and Subordinate Council to recognize one Select Master "for outstanding service to Cryptic Masonry." Since 1975 several hundred have been awarded, and each Constituent Cryptic Grand Master is given the opportunity to recognize one Companion from the jurisdiction who exemplifies the attitude and activities of a Cryptic Mason, and from our Constituent Councils, one for the Triennium.

This honor is bestowed on a Companion who is from the "rank and file" and continuously works over and above the expectations of a member. This outstanding Select Master should be selected using the following criteria:

- A. Only one medal may be awarded annually to a Cryptic Mason in each affiliated Grand Council.
- B. Only one medal may be awarded triennially to a Cryptic Mason in each Constituent Council of the General Grand Council.
- C. Each Grand Council and each Constituent Council shall determine its own method of selecting the Cryptic Mason of the Year in its jurisdiction.
- D. No posthumous awards shall be made.
- E. The award shall be made only for exceptional and meritorious service to Cryptic Masonry above and beyond the call of duty. No Past or Present Grand Master, or any advancing line officer of a Grand Council shall be eligible for this award.
- F. The General Grand Recorder shall be given the Annual Awards Form for a Grand Council filled out in full by the Grand Recorder at least thirty (30) days in advance of the Grand Assembly (or date of presentation if different), forty-five (45) days if outside the continental United States. Constituent Councils shall give the form with the information of the selected Cryptic Mason at least six months prior to the next Triennial Assembly. These timelines allow for engraving, packaging, and shipping, as well as some time for ensuring that all arrives as it should.
- G. The General Grand Recorder shall cause the name of the honoree to be engraved upon the medal and forwarded to the Grand Recorder or Recorder, as appropriate, at the earliest time following receipt of the completed forms.

Named for what is reputed to be the first organized Council of Royal Masters in the United States – Columbia Council No. 1 of New York, which was organized September 2, 1810 – This is an award of merit for service given at the Regional level. Each Triennial, one is awarded to an outstanding Cryptic Mason for each of the Regions of the General Grand Council (now 13), and a maximum of an additional three at large awards given. This award was approved by the General Grand Council during the 33rdTriennial.

When completed, this form is to be sent to the <u>Regional Deputy General Grand Masterfor your Region</u> with a copy to ggcrec@gmail.com. The Regional Deputy must then submit his endorsements to the <u>General Grand Recorder by March 15, 2020</u>. A copy should be sent to the Most Illustrious Grand Master of your Grand Jurisdiction.

The award shall be considered only for exceptional and meritorious service to Cryptic Masonry above and beyond the call of duty. ANY MEMBER, GRAND OFFICER, OR PAST GRAND OFFICER IN GOOD STANDING IS ELIGIBLE FOR THIS AWARD.

We hope you will bring to our attention those Companions who should be considered for this award, it is worth the effort and time to highlight their service to our gentle Craft.

On Saturday, February 27, 2016, the Grand Council of Alabama approved the request of the General Grand Council to assume the responsibility of administering a Ritualist Award for the Royal Master, Select Master, and Super Excellent Master Degrees. This award will be given for work from February 27, 2016, forward.

The requirements for this award are specific to each of the degrees and focus on actual delivery. The best way to track accomplishments is to keep a diary of sorts that can be verified by the Illustrious Master and Recorder of the Council where the work is performed. When the requirements are met, the final verification is completed by the Grand Recorder, the NOMINATION FORM, and then sent to the General Grand Recorder for the issuance of the Jewel.

The structure of earning the award was based on some common considerations:

- The path reflects performance in the Council, this may map to a Companion's work as an officer over time.
- Ritual is an important element of our craft and one deserving of flawless presentation. The expected standard of ritual delivery is from memory complete with full floor work.
- Private exemplification is not allowed, cannot be earned solely through exemplification.
- The Ritual Award and Bars should not be something easily earned.
- The criteria should not be so onerous that it dissuades Companions earning it.
- Certifiers should be qualified by both their position and their knowledge of the ritual.

The desired impacts of the Award:

- By providing a recognition mechanism and therefore incentive, Companions will earn the reward through service as officers in their Council.
- Ritual delivery from memory will be re-established as a standard expectation. The reading of ritual will occur less frequently.
- Overall, a larger population of Companions will be ritually proficient, and continue to do so as a function of time with the Ritual Award program in place.

Individual Award/Bar criteria and forms are available from your Grand Recorder. These should be submitted in full at least thirty days in advance of the desired presentation date.



Henry William Mordhurst Award

Henry William Mordhurst of Indiana served the General Grand Council of Cryptic Masons, International as the General Grand Recorder from September 29, 1886 until his death mid-term on October 19, 1928. Having traveled an exemplary Masonic Journey, his zeal for Cryptic Masonry shown through his forty-two years of dedicated service to the smooth operations of the General Grand Council. It is his record and recording that is referenced when a Companion steps forward and serves as a Grand Recorder for at least ten years with distinction.

The award was started by approval of the General Grand Council at the 33rd Triennial in 1978 and was initially given to any Companion serving his Grand Council as Grand Recorder for 15 years with distinction. Since adoption, there have been fifty-one medals awarded to Companions.

This award is tracked by the office of the General Grand Recorder and is awarded upon verification of election, installation, service, and completion of ten terms of office as a Grand Recorder.

The highest award given to a Cryptic Mason, "a Brother and Companion who is revered by Masons throughout the world and one who has devoted his life to the improvement of Masonry." The Medal of Honor was approved and the first one given at the 33rd Triennial in 1978.

One is given at every Triennial Assembly to one awardee, the decision being made by the elective officers of the General Grand Council based upon recommendations from the Craft. The optimal candidate will have provided service to Masonry and who is well known in the Arts, Science, Business, Religion or Government.

Order of the Secret Vault



The "OSV" is from the General Grand Council International and is a recognition of the Companions continued service to the Council. The Order of the Secret Vault is by invitation only and only those that have received it may make a nomination to the College Dean, who then makes the final selection and forwards the nomination on to the College of Preservation to make the final decision as to who receives the Order. Recipients of this order are known as a Companion of the Secret Vault, and receive a certificate and a jewel to wear.

The General Grand Council has started a new organization under its auspices. The organization is called the College Of Preservation. It consists of the General Grand Officers and select individuals as College Deans. These College Deans will form the core of the selection committee for Companions to be invited to join.

Yes, this is an invitation only organization. If you have been nominated and accepted for membership, an invitation letter will be sent explaining the procedures for becoming a member.

The Companions of the Secret Vault are charged to preserve the degrees of the Council and preserve the General Grand Council. The honorarium is deposited in the Corporate Foundation in an effort to build the Corporate Foundation and delay or eliminate future per capita increases. Now a portion of the earnings may be used to support the General Grand Council Budget.
